Winter Parking


AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SUSQUEHANNA DEPOT,
SUSQUEHANNA COUNTY PA REGULATING WINTER PARKING. THE
ADOPTION OF THIS ORDINANCE WILL REPEAL ORDIANACE #457

It will be illegal to park any vehicle or portion thereof on any Borough Street between November 15th to April 15th of each year after one (1) inch of cumulative snow during a 24 hour period and/or the National Weather Service has issued a "Winter Storm Advisory, Watch, or Warning".

Penalty for violation of this ordinance will be \$50.00 for the first offense; \$100.00 for every subsequent offense. The violator vehicle will be subject to tow without notice at the owner's expenses.

Any vehicle parked on a Borough Street that becomes plowed in or completely snow covered from lack of complying with this parking ordinance will be towed. Any additional expense incurred uncovering the vehicle, prior to towing, will be the responsibility of the owner. Payment for any expenses in removing the snow will be paid prior to the release of the vehicle to the owner(s).


