Minutes – June 11, 2025

Meeting was called to order at 6 p.m. by William Bremenour, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

MOTION: By Sue Crawford, second by Rose Hendrickson to approve the agenda. All were in favor, Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Delta Engineers were on hand to present plans for the RR Crossing design and answered questions. The crossing will be Pedestrians Only entry with emergency vehicle access. Plonkas have some concerns, and they will be looked into further and answered. Plans include three male and three female restrooms which will be connected to the town sewer line, two electric vehicle charging stations.

MOTION: By Al Cuevas, second by Terry Tingley to approve the Minutes of May 14, 2025, as read. All were in favor, Motion carried.

Stone's Excavating bill for Schneider's Market drainage issues was questioned and Kevin filled council in. The problem has not been permanently corrected, but will need to look into available solutions.

MOTION: By Al Cuevas, second by Sue Crawford to approve the Bill List of June 11, 2025. All were in favor, Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS/Police Equipment: Proposal offer was discussed. Use of vehicles for streets was discussed, Kevin stated the truck is definitely not powerful enough to be used for streets. He also suggested that we may be moving along too fast to dispose of all equipment when possible police contracting services might still be possible. Council decided there was no need to rush into getting rid of all the police equipment, so made the decision to postpone accepting proposal.

MOTION: To postpone the sale of Police Equipment. ROLL CALL: William Bremenour, yes; Sue Crawford, yes; Al Cuevas, no; Rose Hendrickson, yes; Terry Tingley, yes. Motion carried.

No updates with Emergency Mgt., and DPW reports reviewed.

The Park Committee has been working on the downtown beautification projects and the new fencing has been put up near the Willow Avenue location.
