Discussion of police vehicles – car worth approx. 12k and the truck is worth approx. 25k – look into possibly listing on Municibid. One weapon cannot be sold to public – possibly sell for parts and destroy.**

**EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT: Willow Avenue project updated. Bldg./property is on the National Register of Historical sights, which means the Historical Preservation Committee is in charge of FEMA operation, and everything will need prior approval from Historical Preservation Committee before proceeding with any work.**

**CODES: Waiting on update from Mike Briechle on the Franklin Avenue project, especially with upcoming summer heat and rats and amount of garbage involved.**

**PARK COMMITTEE: Hometown days discussed. An electrical equipment system needs to be installed in the park in order to accommodate vendors and other electrical needs. It will cost approximately \$2,000.00 which council agreed was needed.**

**DPW: Reports reviewed and Kevin stated they had advertised for summer help.**
