Minutes – May 8, 2024

Meeting was called to order at 6 p.m. by President William Bremenour, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

MOTION: By Chrissy Vinsko, second by Barb Larsen to approve the agenda. All were in favor, Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Adam Mallard from TruView Security Solutions gave a presentation for an updated camera system throughout the parks and downtown area. The system will have the capability of being monitored by the State Police. He did state that the length of data retention could be affected by the current hard drive storage, and therefore may need to be updated.

Kristen Lawrence expressed her concerns of not having local police coverage. Mayor Roy Williams explained the liability issues of lack of police officers, and did inform the public that he would be having discussions with Lanesboro with the intent of possible contracting with them for police coverage, or the possibility of grant writing with possible recruitment of police officers.

MOTION: By Al Cuevas, second by Chrissy Vinsko to approve using Cohen Law firm for reviewing Adams CATV franchise agreement as long as NEP is also included. All were in favor, Motion carried.
